Objectives	₽	To enable selected applicants to undertake research in the realm of their PhD or medical specialisation at one of the 10 Swiss cantonal universities, the two Swiss federal institutes of technology, the public teaching and research institutes or the universities of applied sciences.

Validity	₽	The Scholarship is valid only for full-time research in Switzerland. It is not valid for mixed research (part time in Switzerland and part time in another country). This scholarship is <b>not compatible with fieldtrips outside</b> <b>Switzerland</b> . Therefore no possibility and no funding for fieldwork. Furthermore, this scholarship type is not available for scholars holding a PhD degree. PhD students with an ongoing or planned doctoral project that is carried out within the framework of a formalised agreement between two universities

("cotutelle de thèse" cooperation between a Swiss and a foreign university) and under the joint direction of two supervisors **are eligible for a 12 month research fellowship only**.

Target group	➡ Highly qualified postgraduate researchers from all academic fields as well as young medical doctors.
Duration	A straight ⇒ 12 months maximum (starting in September); no prolongation possible. The research fellowship cannot be upgraded into a prolongable PhD scholarship.
	Grant applications for stays lasting less than 9 months will not be treated as a priority. Grant applications for stays lasting less than 6 months will be rejected.
Amount and additional allowances	<ul> <li>⇒ The scholarship amounts to a monthly payment of CHF 1,920.</li> <li>⇒ For non-EU and non-EFTA grantees only: the FCS pays mandatory Swiss health insurance.</li> <li>⇒ There are no family allowances.</li> <li>⇒ Scholarship holders from non-EU and non-EFTA countries receive a flight allowance (lump sum) for a ticket back to their country of origin (provided at the set of the set</li></ul>
	<ul> <li>the end of the scholarship).</li> <li>⇒ Special CHF 300 housing allowance (paid once at the beginning of the scholarship).</li> <li>⇒ One-year half-fare public transportation card.</li> <li>⇒ Support services and various trips, dinners and sightseeing tours organised for Swiss Government Excellence Scholarship holders.</li> </ul>
Eligibility criteria and specific conditions	<ul> <li>Master's degree or equivalent university degree achieved before 31 July 2020 (degree certificate) recognised by the Swiss university. As a proof, the degree has to be submitted to the Federal Commission for Scholarships before the start of the scholarship.</li> <li>Applicants must be born after 31 December 1984.</li> <li>Applicants who have been in Switzerland since more than one year at the beginning of the scholarship in September are not eligible.</li> <li>Applicants must provide a letter from an academic host professor (including her/his short CV) at the chosen Swiss university confirming why she/he is willing to supervise and support the research. Without such support, the application will be rejected.</li> <li>Applicants must have a research proposal including a timeframe. This is the centrepiece of the application. The applicant must devote all required attention to it.</li> <li>Applicants must be in command of the necessary language skills required for the research/studies.</li> <li>Applicants who have already benefited from a Swiss Government Excellence Scholarship are not eligible to apply for a second scholarship.</li> <li>Scholarship holders are expected to move to Switzerland during their grant period.</li> </ul>
Selection criteria	<ul> <li>⇒ The following aspects and selection criteria are primarily considered:</li> <li>⇒ The candidate: academic profile, research capacity and motivation.</li> <li>⇒ The research project: originality and methodological soundness. The academic context: quality and context of supervision and potential for</li> <li>⇒ future academic cooperation.</li> </ul>
